15:30 Held an exchange meeting with volunteers in the "guidance room"

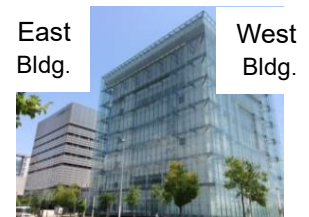
16:00 End of exchange meeting. Dissolution.
